Eligibility:

1. Student must be graduating seniors with a 2.8 or higher grade point average.
2. Student must be pursuing a degree at an accredited institution of higher education (i.e. Junior College, Community College, Technical College, College or University).
3. Student or family must be an active member of GLSRC for at least one year.
4. Student must be involved in school activities.
5. Student must demonstrate community leadership and/or involvement (i.e. Scouting, 4-H, civic group or Club, volunteer work).
6. Student must submit an essay exhibiting dedication to conservation and outdoor activities.
7. Two letters of recommendation must be attached to the application (i.e. teacher, counselor, community leader, employer, clergy).
8. High school/student must submit complete application to the GLSRC by April 20.

Selection process:

The scholarship committee and the Board of Directors will review student qualifications and select those who meet or exceed eligibility requirements by May 15 and will notify recipients.

Disbursement of Funds:

Student may use their scholarship at any accredited institution of higher education (i.e. Junior College, Community College, Technical College, College or University). The money must be used for tuition, books, fees or housing. The GLSRC will work with the student and the college financial aid officer to determine the payee when the check is issued. This will ensure the greatest benefit to the recipient and avoid violation of eligibility requirements. This is a one-time award for one year.
